Re: Return of Auxiliary Property

Dear Board Members of the Calaveras Consolidated Fire Auxiliary:

As you know, the Calaveras Consolidated Fire Auxiliary ("Auxiliary") requested to retrieve its supplies and property from Calaveras Consolidated Fire Protection District ("District") facilities. In a good faith effort to accommodate the Auxiliary's request, representatives from the District and the Auxiliary conducted a walk-through of District facilities to identify and inventory any Auxiliary supplies and property stored on District premises. As a result of that cooperative process, the attached list of supplies and property items were identified as belonging to the Auxiliary.

In addition to the attached list of supplies and property, questions arose with respect to the Auxiliary's ownership of folding chairs and tables stored at District facilities. After further investigation, the District has determined that the Auxiliary owns 147 folding chairs, 26 folding tables and several storage racks for the folding tables that are stored at District facilities. We understand the Auxiliary does not dispute the number of chairs and tables that the District identified as belonging to the Auxiliary.

At this point, the District believes all Auxiliary supplies and property has been identified and accounted for, and that the Auxiliary makes no claim to any other supplies or property stored at District facilities. With this in mind, the District requests that the Auxiliary make arrangements to retrieve the items identified on the attached list of supplies and property, along with the 147 folding chairs, 26 folding tables, and the storage racks for the folding tables, from District facilities as soon as possible. Once the Auxiliary collects these items, the process of returning all supplies and property belonging to the Auxiliary will be complete and the District will deem this matter closed.

Finally, in the spirit of cooperation, the District asks that the Auxiliary return any District property, including pagers and other equipment, issued to members of the Auxiliary. The District

asks that such items be returned to the District at the same time the Auxiliary retrieves its property from the District.

Dear Sirs & Madam,

I am writing to you on behalf of my elderly In-laws, Arlyne and William Halsted; longtime residents of Calaveras County. I'm requesting your assistance in obtaining a satisfactory resolution to their current dilemma.

In the past, I worked for San Joaquin County Adult Protective Services, and found the Board of Supervisors of that county to be very responsive to the needs of their elderly residents. I trust that this is also a priority in your county.

The Halsteds have resided in, and paid taxes to, Calaveras County for the past forty years. They have lived at their current residence of 8466 Hedgepeth Rd in Valley Springs for the past twenty-five years. The property adjacent to their parcel has remained unoccupied and undeveloped. The vegetation has been allowed to proliferate unchecked; thus posing a severe fire hazard to both the Halsteds' property and those in the surrounding area.

The Halsteds have in the past reached out to both the owner of this parcel, and the Calaveras Fire Department without resolution. It is my understanding that the owner's stance is that they feel no responsibility to maintain the property, as it will not perk; it is of no use to them.

We are very appreciative of the members of the fire department. We understand how hard working they are, and how dangerous the services they provide can be, but the truth is that the fire department has been equally unhelpful in this matter. Given the current long-term drought, it is understandable that the fire department is kept very busy, but one would think prevention is a priority to reduce further loss of life and property.

Despite my father-in-law's advanced age and severe health issues, he has consistently kept his own property properly maintained. It is not unreasonable for him to expect that someone take responsibility for the neighboring property. A fire on this neighboring parcel poses the very real possibility of the total loss of his property. His propane tank is located in close proximity to the vacant parcel; and should it ignite, it would quickly consume his home.

I am sure, that whoever the current owner of the parcel happens to be, they are responsible for taxes for the parcel; thus entitled to county resources. It would also seem reasonable that they would be subject to fines for not properly maintaining the land. Even if they have no concern for the outcome of this particular parcel, they must reside somewhere where a levy could be applied. I feel certain that County Counsel is familiar with potential courses of action to obtain the owner's cooperation.

It is our wish that a resolution can be achieved without having to seek legal recourse in this matter. We trust that it is as much a concern and priority for the board, as it is for the residents surrounding the parcel in question.
